

Terms and Conditions of Use

1. Introduction & Acceptance

- Avoid any fraudulent activity, misrepresentation, or identity theft.

4. Responsibilities of Internal Staff

- Access and process records only within the scope of official duties.
- Protect the confidentiality of applicant and case data.
- Follow internal policies and procedures set by the Prosecutor's Office.

5. Prohibited Activities

Users must not:

- Attempt to hack, disrupt, or otherwise compromise the system.
- Use the platform for unlawful purposes.
- Upload or transmit malicious software.
- Access data not intended for them.
